U.S. Firearm Facts


45 SHOTS CAN BE FIRED IN 1 MIN. BY AN AR-15\*

Aurora shooter fired 76 bullets in 2 min.; killed 12, injured 58.

Newtown shooter fired 154 bullets in under 5 min.; killed 26.


\*By comparison, a musket could fire only 3 to 4 rounds per min.

### Shootings By Toddlers: 1 Per Week

In 2015 so far, at least 13 toddlers have killed themselves accidentally with firearms. 18 more injured themselves, 2 killed other people and 10 injured other people.



### Regulating Guns As We Do Vehicles Would Reduce Deaths & Injuries




>90% of households own a vehicle; only 34% own a gun.

Yeah, that sounds about right!




